**RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE RULES OF THE NEW ZEALAND EDUCATIONAL  
INSTITUTE TE RIU ROA INCORPORATED**

Branch/Aronui Tomua/Komiti Pasifika/Area Council: Counties Manukau

Adopted by Meeting on: 21 June 2014.

**RESOLUTION:**

That rule 16.4 is amended and a new rule 16.5 is added as follows:-

- 16.4 Members who earn less than certain income thresholds only pay part of the full subscription rate. The income thresholds will be adjusted each year in the same manner as set out in section 16.2.
- 16.5 The income thresholds and reduced proportions will be set by majority decisions at the Institute's annual meeting.

**PART 2 ARGUMENTS:**

- 16.4 - This change amends the words "certain threshold" to "certain income thresholds" in the current section 16.4. This reflects the current practice of having more than one income threshold and reduced rate.
- This change also enables the income thresholds to be adjusted each year to reflect movements in the Consumer price Index in the same way as the subscription rates are. This would address the income bracket creep problem identified by the Fees Working Party.
- 16.5 - This separates out the second sentence of the current section 16.4 and amends the wording to "certain income thresholds" and "proportions".
